LENT READING PLAN

What is Ash Wednesday? Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a 40-day season marked by repentance, fasting, reflection, and ultimately celebration. During Lent, we take time to focus on Christ's life, ministry, sacrifice, and resurrection and what it means for us as believers.

Use this card as a way to prompt prayer and reflection during the season of Lent

Lent challenge:

Each day of lent (except Sunday), set time aside to do the following things:

1. Begin with 5-10 minutes of uninterrupted silence with the Lord
2. Read the daily Scripture reading (see back of card)
3. Take time to pause and reflect on what you've read (prompts provided on back of card)
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 at least one time
5. Pray the prayer of confession (see back of card)
6. Finish with a worship song

- What does the passage tell you about God?
- What does the passage tell you about yourself?
